Wimbledon

The Lawn Tennis Championships at Wimbledon has developed into one of the greatest annual sporting events in the world and is, undoubtedly, a tournament of the highest quality with in excess of 60 Nations represented. It is estimated that over 500,000 people attend the All-England Club during the fortnight of the main competition.

The 2005 Championships ended on a high note, with stunning victories by the World number one, Roger Federer, who was triumphant in the Men's Singles for the third successive year. Whilst the Ladies Title was won by Venus Williams.

Tim Henman will hope to go at least one better this year, than his four previous semi-final appearances, and with new British hope Andy Murray, British interest is sure to be strong and perhaps Henman's Hill will now become known as Murray's Mound.

Stella Artois Championship

The Queen's Club once again plays host to the premier warm-up tournament, prior to the Wimbledon Championships. Many of the World's top players will be on show, including Andy Roddick, who has now won this title in three consecutive years after beating Ivo Karlovic. Andy Roddick is now only one title away from joining John McEnroe and Boris Becker as the only "four-times champions" at the Stella Artois Championship.

The competition is fierce but does not perhaps have the intensity of 'Wimbledon'. There is ample opportunity for the audience to be in close contact with the competing players and other personalities from the World of tennis.
